- Directions** The event centre will be at the [Portsmouth Arms](#) PH, post code RG22 4RA, [SU617487](#).
- Map/Areas:** 1:5,000 on A3 waterproof paper, 5m contours. The extensive Hatch Warren estate is a gently undulating suburban area with some areas of parkland and woodland borders, presenting plenty of route choice and yardage to cover.
- Courses:** 1 hour straight score event, as per guidelines.  
There will be a yellow/orange course suitable for juniors; torches will be essential. N.B. All juniors under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Punching start, just turn up, register and go!  
EMIT eCards will be used on all courses. Everyone must report to Download afterwards!

Starts: - 18:15 to 19:00
