


Thursday, 15th February, 2024 Wessex Night League Orienteering Race Butlocks Heath Final Details (Updated)

Location: The event centre will be at Hound Parish Hall, Woolston Road, Butlocks Heath,

SO31 5FR, Grid Reference SU 46550 09159, What3Words latest.rift.legal

Parking: There is limited parking near the hall (see below), so please car-share where possible. The hall is 15 minutes walk from Netley Station and is on the Bluestar

No. 15 bus route. Additional parking may be possible on the streets nearby.



Timing: Registration: 17:45 to 18:45

Start times: 18:00 to 19:00

Courses close: 20:00

Facilities:

Toilets and tea/coffee making facilities available in the event centre until approx 21:00. The Cottage Inn is directly opposite for food

Course: 1 hour straight score event, as per Wessex Night League guidelines

Map: 1:5,000 on A3 waterproof paper, 5m contours.

Terrain: Mainly housing estates with some parkland & forest.

Start: Collect eTag from the event hall & go. Start will be near the front of the hall.

Touch free EMIT will be used on all courses. Everyone must report to Download

in the hall afterwards.

Clothing:

All competitors must wear hi-viz tops and have sufficient lights to complete their

course. Whistles should be carried.

Biosecurity: Please come to the event with clean and dry shoes and clothing. After your run please follow the guidance that helps protect our precious environment:

- Check
- Clean
- Dry

Before leaving the event **check** your clothing and equipment and remove any mud, soil or leaf litter.

Once home thoroughly **clean** your footwear and clothing and then leave it to **dry** for as long as possible.

Safety:

All competitors must wear hi-viz tops and have sufficient lights to complete their course. Please take care when crossing any road particularly on the busy roads which are marked on the map in a darker colour. Pedestrian controlled traffic lights are marked as purple optional crossing points. All juniors under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.

and O-Safe:

Photography There are no official photographers for this event. Photography is not allowed in the toilets or any "changing area" including the car park. Any concerns with photography or the behaviour of anyone toward any child or young adult must be reported to the event organiser or other

official.

Safeguarding is everyone's responsibility, play your part, report any

Dogs are not allowed in the event centre. Dogs should be kept under Dogs:

control and on a lead when out on the course.

Risk assessment:

Please note that if you have competed in three orienteering events and

have not joined an orienteering club that is a member of British

Orienteering, then you are not covered by this insurance.
