#### **Yellow 2.5km**

*Novice course. All on paths. Suitable for beginners.*

#### **Orange 3.3km**

*Novice course. Mostly on paths, but corners can be cut. Suitable for improvers.*

#### **Short Green 3.7km**

*Orienteering experience required.*

#### **Green 4.8km**

*Orienteering experience required.*

#### **Blue 7.2km**

*Orienteering experience required.*

**Course lengths are approximate.**

### Event Information

#### **Entry**

Entries are online only and will close at midday on the day of the event - i.e. EOD is available but you will need to enter online.

To guarantee a run on your preferred course, please enter before midnight on Sunday 1st October. After this time places will be limited to the available maps.

Mixed undulating forest with a good network of line features. The Blue course will venture out onto the open heathlands and bogs of Yew Tree Bottom.
